Juror Everett Raymond Kinstler

Everett Raymond Kinstler, NA, AWS began his career as an illustrator for books and magazines. He has taught at the Art Students League and National Academy School, NYC since 1969. His classes are focused on painting and drawing from life and nature. His landscapes, figures and interiors have been featured in over fifty books. Over time, he established himself as one of the nation's foremost portrait painters.

Kinstler has painted over 1,000 portraits. Seven US presidents have posed for him. His portraits of Gerald R. Ford and Ronald Reagan are the official White House portraits. Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery owns 100 of his works. In 1999, they awarded him the Copley Medal, its highest honor. He holds two honorary doctorates and is represented in the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Brooklyn Museum and Butler Institute of American Art. In 2006, The Museum of the City of New York presented a four-month exhibition of his paintings and drawings. Currently, a PBS documentary on his career is being shown nationally.

Awards

Ribboned awards will be made at the discretion of the juror for First Prize (\$100), Second Prize (\$75) and Honorable Mention (\$50).

Eligibility

Open to all artists 18 years of age and over.

Two entries per artist (abstract and/or representational art accepted): oils, acrylics, watercolors, drawings, pastels, mixed media only.

Gallery wrap will be accepted at the discretion of EAC.

Sculpture will be accepted. Sculptors must provide their own pedestals.

No gicleé, canvas transfers, photography or computer images. Substitutions and/or late entries will not be accepted.

Restrictions

Artwork must be framed and wired for hanging and labeled on back with artist's name, phone number, medium, title and price (please use artwork labels supplied). Artists must hand deliver and pick up their work at the Bradley-Hubbell House in Easton. Artwork must be available from delivery date through end of show.

Size limit not to exceed 24" horizontally (including frame)

Sales

All artwork must be for sale. A commission of 30% on all work sold will go to the EAC. Funds raised will be used for the restoration of the historic Bradley-Hubbell House and promoting the arts in Easton.

USPS Mail-in submission requirements

Quality 8.5 x11 color photograph or quality slide of each entry, or quality image CD file. Mark each entry with artist's name, full title, width, height, medium and price. **Include entry forms and fee.**

Include SASE for return, if desired.

Email submission requirements

Attach a high-quality image file of each entry.

Please include the following information:

Name each image attachment: your last name / title.

In the email subject line: Art in the House / your last name.

In body of email: Artist's name, email, phone number and address;

plus for each image: full title, width, height, medium and price.

NOTE: entry forms and fee must be mailed in at this time.

Entry Fee - nonrefundable

\$25 for the first entry, \$5 for second. Maximum of two entries.

Juror Notification - Monday, April 26, 2010

A list of accepted works will be posted on the EAC website, www.eastonartscouncil.org by April 27, 2010. Selected artists will also be notified by email.

(Artists not notified should assume their work was not accepted.)

Receiving - Sunday, May 2, 2010 - 10am to 3pm

Artwork must be framed and wired for hanging with completed label adhered to back of work, lower left-hand side. Pedestals must be provided by sculptor.

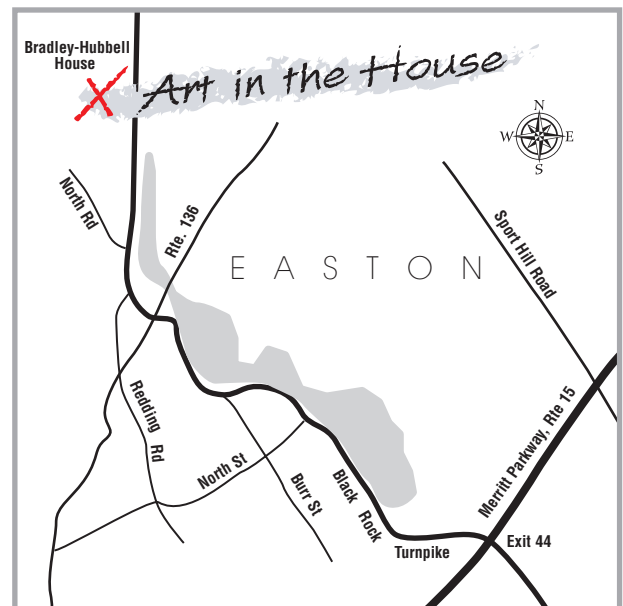
A portfolio table will be provided.

Hand deliver to: Bradley-Hubbell House, 535 Black Rock Turnpike, Easton, CT. (See map below.)

Pickup of Artwork - Sunday/Monday, May 16/17

All work not sold must be removed by Sunday, 5/16/10, 4-6pm or Monday, 5/17/10, 9:30am-noon. Artists also responsible for portfolio removal at this time.

If work is not picked up on time, there will be a \$50.00 administrative charge. After thirty days, the art will become the property of EAC. It is a condition of entry to the exhibition that the above be understood and agreed to by the artist in signing the attached entry form.
